We, the Seniors of Athens High School, present the 1966 TROJAN, hopeful that this book combines the many things that will establish Athens High School forever in our memories.


It is with great pride and grateful appreciation that we dedicate this 1966 issue to the Senior Sponsors, Perry Hill and Nancy Bailey.


# SCIENCE CLUB




